The warm weather is finally upon us and we hope you are having the opportunity to go out and enjoy it safely. We at NJPTA continue to be committed to being socially responsible while also being responsible to you our patients' well being with medical conditions.

We are OPEN and continue to treat patients who have a significant medical condition, or chronic pain condition that requires continuity of care. The schedule is open and new referrals and patients are being accepted and scheduled. The number of patients continues to be limited so as to eliminate waiting room time and interpatient interaction, as well as, provide treatment in private room areas. We continue to ask patients to call the office (Hackettstown: 908-852-7575, Morristown: 973-538-8877) as they arrive in the parking lot prior to coming into the office so we can maximize safe distances between patients and staff. We also ask that all patients continue to wear masks and continue to wash their hands before and after treatment. Treatment tables and equipment are sanitized prior to each patient treatment.

We will keep you updated as we all proceed through this unprecedented time. If you note a worsening of your condition/problem/pain related to not coming in, we urge you to schedule at least one appointment to reassess and update your program.
